A Clarion Call to Our Collective Emergence and Planetary Integrity

We are living in a rare and exquisite time on the planet today, a period in our collective evolution that will be referred to as one of the greatest mystical renaissances of all times; a radical return to the essential – to our original nature – in all aspects of life. The mystic Bede Griffith referred to this as the “*Hour of God*,” a moment when everything is at stake, when a vast shift of consciousness will have to take place on a massive scale in all societies and religions for the world to survive. These times are marked by a heightened and concentrated state of emergence; an increase in universal complexity, potency, creativity and chaos. On the surface the conditions of our “collective dark night of the soul” — the global crisis and the breakdown of economic, environmental, educational and healthcare systems and structures — seem to indicate a time of despair, leaving us baffled and wondering “*what is going wrong here?*” However, these adverse conditions are playing a critical role in activating a deep and powerful emergence; a resurgence of our individual and collective Soul.

It is indeed darkest before the dawn and yet the dark, mysterious grounds of gestation give rise to new life. The darkness is an essential and integral ingredient in the bringing forth and rising up of a new world order and a new mankind. Without the dark damp earth pressing down and in on the seed, it will stay dormant. And so it is with our own personal and collective Soul. It is from within the darkness of the “emergency” in which we now find ourselves that the great emergence will occur. The lines between the death of the old and the birth of the new are blurring, one spilling into, initiating and informing the other. Unplanned and uncontrolled, this collective chaos bears the true mark of the Divine — chaos giving rise to order, darkness revealing a truer and more radiant Light, beauty born in depths of despair. Our choice is ultimately a choice-less one – we can surrender to the emergence and powerfully co-create from within it or we can stagnate and die. Resistance is ultimately futile and will only serve to increase our individual and collective suffering. Yet, what is it we are surrendering to? We are surrendering to the Divine blueprint, an emerging design for a world that works for all, blesses all, considers and includes all.

There has never before, in the history of our world, been a time as ripe with possibility and transformation as this. There is a great emergence awakening from its dormant slumber, sweeping across the face of the planet, ushering in the consciousness and the potential for the creation of a new earth – a world-wide beloved community with its foundation in planetary integrity – unconditional love, peace, joy, harmony and oneness. All of creation is engulfed in the momentum and magnitude of this change. Tapping the sacred force and power of this emergence requires that we shift our focus from “*what is going wrong here?*” and begin asking

one of the most powerful questions for our times. The question and its inspired answer will guide us into co-creative partnership with the emergence and into grounded, sacred action.

What is seeking to emerge?

The words of Jesus in the *Gospel of Thomas* (Logion 70) bring us directly into the heart of this question as he urges us to choose life, saying: *“If you bring forth what is within you, what you bring forth will save you. If you do not bring forth what is within you, what you do not bring forth will destroy you.”*

This is the razor’s edge and holy ground on which we are standing. This is the universal clarion call to personal and planetary integrity that calls us to be empowered and potent leaders and co-creators in the emerging paradigm. And as “emergent leaders” we are called to attend to the simultaneous falling away of what no longer serves and the rising up of the new. As we become fully present with the “emergency” we are able to retrieve the activating seed of emergence concealed within it. The antidote is in the poison. The contraction is occurring within the greater expansion. Embracing these contradictions is what allows us to be fully present and receptive to the conception and ensuing gestation of the next evolution of consciousness and birthing of Divine potentiality in the real conditions of our lives and in the world.

This is the Law of Emergence

The Law of Emergence proclaims that all things are in a state of becoming, gestating and bringing forth in each moment; everything is dynamically moving and spiraling into greater expressions of wholeness, brilliance and oneness. The 14th century mystic Meister Eckhart referred to this constant birthing of brilliance as “God giving birth to God in and through all of Creation.” He states, *“We are celebrating the feast of the Eternal Birth which God the Father has borne and never ceases to bear in all eternity... But if it takes not place in me, what avails it? Everything lies in this, that it should take place in me.”* He goes on to say, *“What does God do all day long? He gives birth. From the beginning of eternity God lies on a maternity bed giving birth to the All. God is creating this whole universe, full and entire, in this present moment.”*

It is in and through each and every one of us that the birth and the emergence of a global shift in consciousness will become realized. It is through the inspired and sacred act of becoming in manifest form that which we already are in essence, that the face of the planet and the whole of humankind will reflect in an ever-growing glory, the Divine image. And it is through understanding, applying and living the Law of Emergence that this potentiality moves from being possible to becoming inevitable.

Introducing the Law of Emergence

The Law of Emergence is an ancient mystical, scientific, natural and biological law that is at the epicenter of facilitating the evolutionary shift and the creation of a New Earth. It is one of the most powerful and creative universal laws underlying the whole of creation. It is the *divine impulse* and creative principle in action, in motion and in expression. It is propelling all Life forward into greater wholeness, expression and realization. It seeks powerful, life-giving pathways, structures, systems, organizations and relationships to infuse with its grandeur, creativity and awe. It is holographic in nature and operates in all dimensions of creation from the macro to the micro, the universal to the personal and the cosmological to the cellular. It is the underlying, organizing principle behind the arrival of new unexpected structures, patterns and processes, the creative spontaneity of jazz groups playing live, the formation of snowflakes, the construction of "cathedrals" built by termites, the existence of the Internet and the caterpillar's transformation into a butterfly.

The Law of Emergence states that there is a *divine potentiality* desiring to be born in and through you. This divine potentiality, this "*Divine Idea*," is the predominant creative force in your life – more than your conscious or subconscious awareness or "limited mind." The "Divine DNA" is encoded within your deepest desire and directs you towards your destiny. It is calling you forth, moving you forward and beckoning you to new expressions and experiences of greatness. It is available in each moment as you become present to it, making yourself available and choosing its circuitous and surrendered path. It is conspiring on your behalf to create the optimal conditions for your own emergence as a fully expressed divine human being. This divine potentiality is what is referred to as *entelechy* — the Greek root is *entelécheia*. Aristotle described entelechy as the condition of *something whose essence is fully realized and actualized*. Entelechy is the vital, creative life force that motivates and guides an organism, a person, a planet and a cosmos toward fulfillment. It is the wild, unbridled expression of Eros, of love seeking the expression and embodiment of wholeness. It is the "*Christic Principle*" of being made in the Divine image and likeness – "*imago dei*," here to do "*greater things than this*."

The Law of Emergence is universal principle, an “isness,” that is an integral to the unfolding of all life. It is the unseen, underlying rhythm, cadence and motion of your life. It is the source of brilliance, intelligence and grace that lives and moves within the core of your being, it is your native nature. It describes, in essence, an all-knowing, all-powerful, always-present Divine Presence in the continuous process of gestation, creation and manifestation within you, through you and as you. It is described within the ancient story of Genesis as the Spirit of God hovering over the unified Soul in the act of creation, arising from emptiness and blossoming outward into the expression of life. The world is the body of God and God is the body of the world, speaks to the power of creativity and emergence that is Life itself.

The Law of Emergence supports people in living, thriving and serving in the new paradigm of oneness, presence, love and global sufficiency. It prescribes a way of being in deep integrity and in harmonious relationship with Life and all that comprises it. It is a fundamental, core shift in how we as humans understand life and our place within it. Once you come to fully understand and re-member the Law of Emergence you will exhale in relief, knowing that all things are truly working in and for your good and the good of the All. Seemingly random, chaotic or despairing events and experiences can now be understood and perceived in an expanded context and as an integral aspect of your greater wholeness coming into being.

There is great peace and relaxation that accompanies the knowing and the embodiment of this spiritual truth. It allows us to relax and to deepen the roots of our being in a calm and receptive presence. It invites us to a deep and reverential listening, to become still enough to witness, hear, taste and “catch” the emergence as it moves in and through us and as it swirls around us beckoning us onward, upward and inward to new expressions of being in life.

The Law of Emergence offers us grace in our becoming and peace within our unknowing. It releases a watershed of stress and effort from our overly anxious and striving minds and egos, granting us permission to return to a peaceful pace and ease of life. It offers us a nourishing and sustaining communion with the Creator and the creation that we are and that we are

becoming. It renders us powerless to the greater movements of Life. It asks for our surrender to the source of brilliance, to the Divine potentiality and possibility. It reminds us that there is a Divine idea, solution and expression already in the process of gestation and coming forth. It shows us that if we surrender our ideas and intentions to the Divine, we activate the territory of brilliance.

Living the Law of Emergence

In the fast paced, technology-driven culture, many people are experiencing a disconnection from the more rhythmic and soulfully-directed pace of the natural world. Within our frantic searching of achieving and consuming, we have forgotten or become de-sensitized to this powerful law and to our own emergence. The images and information we receive from media propel us into a fear-based acquisition binge of “got to have ‘it,’ bigger is better, more is merrier, I’ve got to get my stuff and secure my good before someone else gets it.” And yes, we can operate in this mode up until a point. And that point is here now. Using our creative power and will to create “solutions” that pacify our egos but keep our soul’s fulfillment and contribution suppressed and unrealized can no longer be sustained. They are impotent in the course of the grand emergence and creation you are now ready to participate within.

Often times in my own life, I have attempted to use intention or the Law of Attraction to control and manipulate the conditions of my life – to “get out” of an experience I was having or to avoid painful emotions or to get an experience I believed I wanted to have. The Law of Emergence reveals another way, inviting us into presence and into the creative process of actively, dynamically surrendering to our experience and all that is arriving in each moment. Every sensation, emotion, thought, feeling, desire and action becomes fuel for our emergence. In the Law of Emergence nothing is preferred or denied; presence to the arising experience of each moment and deep congruence and integrity with it are what allows the creative emergence to burst forth and flow through our lives. Denying, manipulating, forcing and trying become useless and impotent strategies that only serve to abort, delay and divert the emergence. In the words of Thomas Merton, “There is in all things, a hidden wholeness.”

Never look upon the discords and disharmonies of your life as if they represented a lack of understanding or a lack of demonstration. Regard these unfortuitous circumstances as opportunities which will be dissolved when they no longer serve their purpose as spurs to your spiritual unfoldment. You are the temple of the living God; your life, your soul, your mind is the abiding place of truth. Let this truth abide in you.

The Law of Emergence invites, invokes and evokes a sacred alchemy that fuses the mystical dimensions with the human dimensions. Everything is swirling together in the art of becoming. In this alchemy you become the mystical artist and co-creator of Life. You begin to dance with your Self and your life in increasing flow, freedom, creativity, responsiveness and spontaneity. You begin to trust the Divine Impulse to move you – experiencing the “mover” and the “moved” in a dance of sacred union and co-creative bliss. There is great relief in no longer employing your limited mind and resources to “figure things out” or to intend, imagine or attract a future experience that you believe will bring about a desired experience. There is a great peace found in this truth as you descend below the habitual thoughts of an over-active mind, into the heart of knowing.

Take a moment now to pause and receive a breath, asking yourself, *“What peace and grace would be available to me if I truly knew that all things are emerging in my life according to the Divine idea and Divine plan and are occurring in Divine time?”* *What if I could believe that there is nothing off track or wrong with me, my life or the conditions that I am currently experiencing? Who would I be? How would I be? What action would I take? What would happen if I fully embodied the truth that I am having the perfect experience for my soul’s emergence into greater wholeness and service regardless of whether I like it or not?*

Being in deep integrity with our own emergence and the emergence occurring in life – the precious “what is” of our lives – is one of the most powerful and creative decisions we can enact on the planet today. It is the sacred act of becoming present to our own “becoming” and the larger “becoming” surrounding us. It requires our full presence and a subtle attunement to what is being asked for and what is essential in each moment. *“What is wanted? What is needed in this present moment to support the unfolding, the essential emergence that is occurring within me, within life?”* These questions create an “elegant intervention” into consciousness, opening us to an expanded state of being and facilitating inspired creation. The questions, posed to the inner soul – the still small voice of inspired guidance – often receive answers that are simple and subtle. The Law of Emergence guides us into an elegant and authentic movement sourced in inner congruence and richness that is sustained and builds into greater expression and becoming.

In the Law of Emergence our inner-environment, our inner world and the outer reflection and expression in our lives are the main playing field and Petri dish for our emergence and our

creative contribution. It is richly laden with symbolism, meaning, guidance and creative inspiration. Yet, too often we are numb to it, sleep-walking through life unaware of the treasure that is available. We have forgotten how to perceive and receive the guidance from our own Soul – we do not have eyes to see or ears to hear the great emergence dancing at our feet. There is essential nourishment for us if we are willing to bring forth the kingdom of riches that are lying dormant and beginning to awaken within us into the outer expression of our lives. The inside becomes the outside and the outside becomes the inside. It is anything but self-serving to deeply know the self as an act of contributing to the greater emergence of the whole. In the *Gospel of Thomas* (Logion 67), Yeshua explains, “He who understands the All, but lacking himself, lacks everything.”

He goes on to describe the inner congruence and outer expression that the Law of Emergence bring us into in Logion 22:

Jesus saw some babies nursing. He said to his disciples, "These nursing babies are like those who enter the kingdom."

They said to him, "Then shall we enter the kingdom as babies?"

Jesus said to them, "When you make the two into one, and when you make the inner like the outer and the outer like the inner, and the upper like the lower, and when you make male and female into a single one, so that the male will not be male nor the female be female, when you make eyes in place of an eye, a hand in place of a hand, a foot in place of a foot, an image in place of an image, then you will enter the kingdom."

The Law of Emergence redirects our pursuit of outer riches and experiences to the inward pursuit of receiving and expressing the indwelling riches, the ruby precious gem of our own Soul. *Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and all else will be added and given unto you.* It is heartbreaking to consider that we can live our lives without truly knowing God, as God expresses as our own essence, Soul and authentic Self. It is this experience for which we most hunger. It is a sacred hunger of longing for deep integrity and congruence with the essential Self and thus all of Creation, which is what the emergence both serves and satisfies.

The Law of Emergence guides us to this relationship and asks that we give birth to the essential within our own lives. *What is essential in your life?* Often times we don't know how to respond when asked this question. We may rattle off a stream of answers that may or may not hold truth and deep meaning. *What is truly essential for the unfolding of brilliance, wholeness and being that is seeking to emerge within me? What are the essential nutrients to feed and fuel this emergence? What inner states of being can I foster to stimulate and activate the emergence? What inspired and guided actions can I take?* The essential – the Soul -- has a voice and the voice resides at the core of your being and is the vortex of your emergence.

Listening for the essential will guide you into a powerful relationship with the Law of Emergence. The essential is the radiating and all-powerful core of the emergence – God, Life, Love, and Soul. Coming home to the essential will place you immediately into the all-powerful, ever present, all knowing, supra-potent field of emergence.

Opening to the emergence requires a devotion and donation of the entirety of your being, your life and your living. The activation asks for this and invites this. You will be consumed and you want to be consumed by this Divine Force and ripe possibility. It asks you to slip inside it, to disrobe and disarm your defenses and allow the Divine to pulse and tremor within your heart, mind, body and soul – to take precedence and dominion over the inner and outer conditions of your life.

The Law of Emergence is alive. It is potent. It is life-force. When you are in its field your heart pounds and your breath quickens. The ripeness can be intoxicating and alluring as well as frightening and overwhelming. The Law of Emergence is the all sustaining, forever-creating energy of life force as it moves and animates your being. It plays you like an instrument of love and life, for that is what you are.

Emergence is both Divine and human.
It is mystical and erotic.
It is consciousness and it is the manifestation of consciousness.
It is appearing and disappearing;
It is arriving and departing, dissolving and coalescing.
It is the dance of life.
It asks for all.
It gives all.

Emergence brings us into a deep, integrous, congruous, communion with Life. It is the intention and the foundation of all co-creation. There is no separation between the Creator and the Created; the impulse and the expression are indistinguishable merged in a unity of motion. Emergence centers us in a holy, wholly love affair with ourselves and with life. Rather than something to be managed or forced or made to happen, life becomes an organic, opening flowing from one moment to the next, from one movement to the next.

The question for our times is can we, will we, let go into this ocean of brilliance that will birth us into our greatest expression? Will we leave the deadness and choose an ever-increasing aliveness, zest and enthusiasm for life? Will we dive in and let the river move us and take us to our ultimate belonging? Can we admit that the plans and structures we have created for ourselves are too small and suffocating for the life that now wants to live in us and celebrate its existence as us?

Can we trust? Will we surrender? Do we have the capacity for this great letting go that is now upon us? Are we willing to die into new life?

Understanding the Law of Emergence is becoming increasingly important as we are reaching a level of complexity in our lives and in the world where it is critical that we avail ourselves, open ourselves and surrender ourselves to the Divine Idea, the blueprint of our collective Soul. We cannot “figure or force” our way out of the global challenges we are facing with the environment, healthcare, global economy, hunger, education and world relations. And it is these challenges and the fear they evoke that can actually fortify our control when a deeper and more dynamic surrender is being called for. Can we trust that from the void of unknowing, from the emptiness and stillness of non-action that a deeper, truer direction and destiny will reveal itself? That a true course of action sourced in Oneness and the highest good of all will emerge? There is a direction and trajectory that will lead us individually and collectively into greater expressions of wholeness, oneness and love. Can we wait until the mud settles so we can see clearly that which is seeking to emerge? Can we move beyond the polarized states of our perceptions, suspend affiliation with a perspective, politic or opinion so that we might be

fully receptive to a way where no way has been before? This is the great challenge, and this is the great adventure and opportunity we are being presented with. This is the precipice at which we stand. This is the time of a great letting go into the deeper, soulful waters of emergence.

Principles of the Law of Emergence

The Law of Emergence offers that (these statements to be referenced):

- All Life (plant, animal, human, cosmos, and universe) is in a constant, continuous and interconnected unified state of creative emergence moving into greater expressions of wholeness and oneness which includes periods of entropy, breakdown and chaos as Life reorders into greater wholeness and consciousness.
- There is a Divine idea, movement, impulse and spark that is expressing in and through each and every one of us. This Divine trajectory is always seeking to move towards and into greater and more expansive expressions and experiences of wholeness, oneness, brilliance and well-being.
- There is a divine potentially, a simultaneously unique and integral possibility that desires to come into expression and embodiment (manifestation) through you; it is the Divine idea that created you and continues to birth you into your next expression.
- Emergence inherently operates within the Law of Oneness and thus, is in service to the highest good of all life regardless of the appearance of outer conditions and our judgments of those conditions as “good” or “bad” and “preferred” or “rejected.”
- Free will operates in subservience to the Law of Emergence in that you can choose to divert, delay and suppress your divine essence, nature or blueprint, but it will eventually express and exists regardless of your resistance.
- Cultivating the inner conditions of emergence (implosion) transforms potentiality into actuality (explosion). Emergence occurs from the inner to the outer – this is what is described in the scripture “seek ye first the Kingdom and all else will be added unto you.”

- The Law of Emergence becomes activated and accelerated as you energize your intention to “choose Life” and surrender to its desire for you, which is also your desire for Life. Becoming present to your desire for Life (wholeness, oneness, creation, love, joy) opens a doorway to the dimension of emergence where the universal Life Force can and will sweep you away into an upward spiral.
- Emergence within human dynamics occurs within a specific scale in the all-embracing spiral like structure of the galaxy. Human emergence mirrors the spiral like all embracing nature of the cosmos, the universe itself.
- The Law of Emergence operates within the same regulating forces that have created nature in all of her forms and are also responsible for the structure of our psyche and our ability to think.
- We are inextricably connected to the never-ending, inexhaustible treasure of creative energy, Universal Life Force through our inner connection and unity.
- The Law of Emergence is inherently co-creative and relational, co creation naturally occurs as an integral aspect of emergence.
- Overly developed control mechanisms, reasoning and logic as well as an addiction to the illusions of perfection, safety, security and independence are deterrents to the emergence.
- Emergence operates in the field of oneness, presence, communion, unconditional love and pure potentiality – perceiving the wholeness of existence is foundational to emergence.
- The Law of Emergence exists and operates within a supra-charged, highly creative zone – a vortex – a powerfully potent, fertile zone, where we are co-sensing, co-creating, co-influencing, co-emerging and co-existing.
- The Divine Presence is constantly present and continuously changing as we emerge and evolve, this describes a dynamic interchange between the creator and the creation; the changeless and the changing.

- Whatever resists emergence is condemned to death; emergence is vital for all forms of life. The question of “what is seeking to emerge within me, within my life?” is not a self-indulgent question; it is core to our collective co-creation.
- Emergence operates with deep integrity to the essence of life and the essential nature of each person. Emergence moves every person into greater attunement, alignment and expression of your unique Divine Human nature – your Soul.
- Emergence requires a period of incubation, transformation and transfiguration – “chrysalis time” -- a container for the seed to be protected and nourished before it emerges outwardly.
- Emergence has its own organic development with a natural cycle, rhythm and direction that must be honored, allowing the emergence without imposing our reasoning, timeline or will is important to the unfolding -- where the outward form may take time to emerge.
- Universal, collective and personal emergences are “One” – interconnected, intertwined, inextricable – nested holograms – they inform, impact and inspire one another. Example of the Mobius strip.
- Full presence and inner congruence are required to perceive, receive and foster the emergence; without these inward conditions and the development of inner clarity the energies of the emergence (thoughts, emotions, desires, ideas, etc.) can create more confusion, illness, suffering and sorrow.
- Freeing ourselves from the burdens of the past and the future creates availability in present time to sense, experience and engage the emergence.
- Emergence occurs in the nonlinear world of spontaneity, impulse, and chaos – as long as linear thinking and strictly logical inference dominate our lives, the emergence remains unnoticed and untended. The power of logic, reasoning and intention can operate only with what follows after the emergence occurs.

- Emergence requires the full participations of our being – consciousness, mind, heart, body and soul. Without a focus on expanding our consciousness beyond the limitations of our ego-centered thoughts and desires to the essential movements of the Soul and thus to grow in wisdom, the emergence will never reveal her secrets to us.
- Emergence cannot be fully known, described or contained for it is emerging as well and operates within the continued unfolding and creation of the Great Cosmic Mystery.
- Emergence is intrinsically holographic and operates within the unified field of consciousness, spanning dimensions, realities and galaxies.
- If we want to live and thrive in the vortex of Emergence we must develop our inner capacities (what are referred to in this book as the “The Seven Sacred Seeds of Emergence) and nurture the inner-environment, the inner vortex, sanctum, crucible. This is the cultivation of a new state of consciousness and creation of the divine human being.
